Confidence to stay active

Shortness of breath and the anxiety experienced during dyspnea is a real concern for those suffering from Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD). Many avoid daily activities to reduce the risk of experiencing these episodes.

The Philips VitaBreath dyspnea relief device is the first non-pharmaceutical device used as an adjunct therapy for COPD patients to provide short-term relief of shortness of breath associated with physical exertion.

VitaBreath is small, light weight and powered by a long life lithium ion battery, offering users portability and discretion.



Key clinical facts

- Reduces COPD-related dyspnea recovery time
- Makes it easier to breathe when short of breath
- Reduces the severity of shortness of breath when used during or after daily activities, such as walking
- Reduces the time it takes for COPD patients to complete daily activities

Key technical facts

- One button interface - simply press the button to start VitaBreath
- Uses bi-level pressure therapy to relieve COPD-related shortness of breath
- Rechargeable lithium ion battery with up to 3 days of battery life
- Can be used either in or outside of the home
- Uses ambient air to create positive pressure, helping to relieve COPD-related shortness of breath brought on by physical exercise or exertion



Bi-level breathing support

Provides positive inspiratory pressure to reduce work of breathing. Positive expiratory pressure keeps airways open.



Drug-free recovery

Uses positive airway pressure to help patients recover. Can be used with other therapies that help patients manage their COPD.



Easy to clean

Removable mouthpiece and cap, which can be washed with water and a mild detergent.



Fast start up

Press the start button, wait for VitaBreath to warm up and begin breathing through the mouthpiece.



Portable and lightweight

Up to 3 days of battery life, small enough to fit in a coat pocket and ready to use at a moment's notice.
